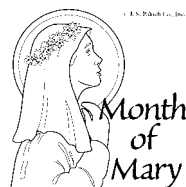

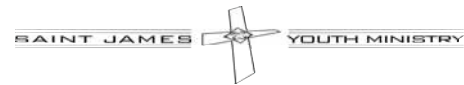

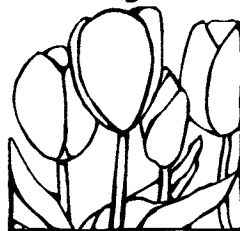


St. James - St. Leo Catholic Community will have a Novena of Masses offered for Mother's Day.

TRANSFORMACIÓN

Cuando limpiamos, reparamos o restauramos los objetos que poseemos, a menudo decimos "casi como nuevo". Esto, según el libro del Apocalipsis, es lo que ocurre con cualquier cosa que está llena de la gloria de Dios. Cuando la Biblia emplea la palabra "nuevo" no es un mero "diferente, mejorado" (como suelen decir los avisos comerciales), sino que acarrea un nuevo sentido de algo que ha sido transformado tan plena y completamente que ahora resulta casi irreconocible. Nuestro mundo está lleno de lágrimas, muerte, dolor, sed y oscuridad; pero el nuevo mundo —el nuevo cielo y la nueva tierra que trae la resurrección de Cristo— está lleno de gozo, vida eterna, gloria, agua viva y luz. Como observara san Pablo en la segunda carta a la iglesia de Corinto, si estamos en Cristo, entonces somos una nueva creación. Y aquellos discípulos que son también una nueva creación, que viven en el nuevo cielo y la nueva tierra que trae Cristo, también son los diarios practicantes del nuevo mandamiento de amarse unos a otros con el amor transformador y renovador que Cristo nos ha otorgado.
