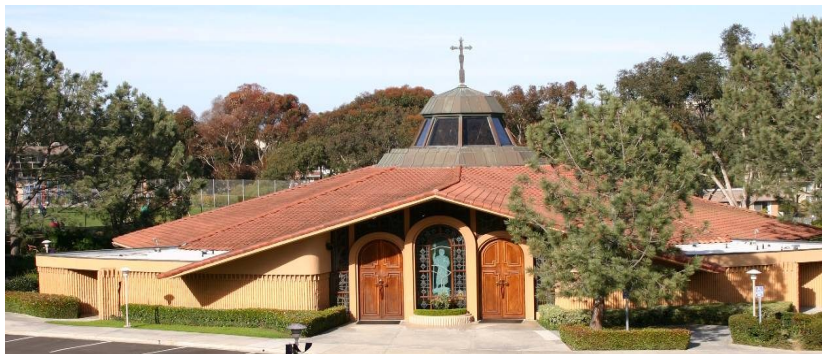

**STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION**

As we enter the Fall, we realize it's the season for harvest, not only for agricultural crops, but also for the spiritual fruit we should have produced during the liturgical year nearing completion. God's people have often failed to produce the harvest they should.



Such is the case with the ancient Israelites, whom Isaiah compared with a vineyard which produced only sour, wild grapes. Jesus used the vineyard image, but introduced tenants who refused to turn over his share of the harvest to the landowner. They will be replaced by people who will obey the terms of the agreement, and others will be welcomed into the kingdom of God. How do we measure up with the harvest of spiritual gifts we should develop and turn over to God?

Lest we lose heart, St. Paul reminds us that we are to "have no anxiety at all." Indeed, even our requests should be offered to God "with thanksgiving." We have a fuller revelation of God's will for us, and a never-ending stream of grace from the sacraments. If we keep our minds on what is true, pure, and excellent, "then the God of peace will be with you.

**A HARVEST OF LOVE & COMPASSION**

Today's Gospel reading poses some challenging stewardship questions. When Christ returns, will we be found working diligently in the Lord's "vineyard;" converting our own hearts into a rich harvest of love and compassion? Calling those outside our vineyard to enter into the joy of the Lord? Or will we just be living, taking advantage of what the Lord has given us, but not doing our part in return? Jesus' parable suggests that if we aren't good stewards of the gifts we've been given then the gifts will be taken away, and we will be called to give an account for our failures. We have all we need for a bountiful harvest. What will our Lord find when He returns?

**STEWARDSHIP PRAYER**

*Gracious and Loving God,  
We give you thanks for this time of year;  
a time of transformation that reveals the awe-inspiring gift of your creation.  
Teach us how to be good stewards of all the gifts you have given us; and show us how we may share those gifts generously, especially with those most in need of your loving care.  
Give us the strength to be good stewards of the Gospel, to love others as we love ourselves, and to follow in your Son's footsteps, until we find our way home to you.  
We pray this through your Son, Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit,

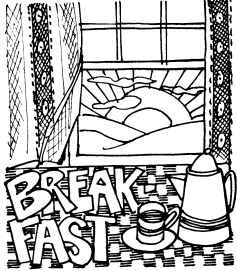

## REFLEXION DOMINICAL

Como entramos al Otoño, nosotros nos damos cuenta de que es la temporada para la cosecha, no sólo para las cosechas agrícolas, sino también para la frutos espirituales que debemos de haber producido durante el año litúrgico que se acerca a su terminación. Las personas de Dios a menudo han fallado para producir la cosecha que deberían.



Tal es el caso con los antiguos israelitas, quien Isaías comparó con una viña que produjo sólo uvas agrias y salvajes. Jesús utilizó la imagen de viña, pero los arrendatarios que se negaron a compartir la cosecha con el dueño de la viña. Serán reemplazados por personas que obedecerán los términos del acuerdo, y a otros les darán la bienvenida en el reino de Dios. ¿Nosotros cómo medimos la cosecha de regalos espirituales que debemos desarrollar y debemos entregar a Dios?

Por temor a que nosotros nos desanimemos, San Pablo nos recuerda que no debemos "tener ningún ansiedad". Verdaderamente, aún nuestras peticiones deben ser ofrecidas a Dios "con acciones de gracias". Tenemos una revelación más completa de la voluntad de Dios para nosotros, y es una corriente interminable de gracias por los sacramentos.
