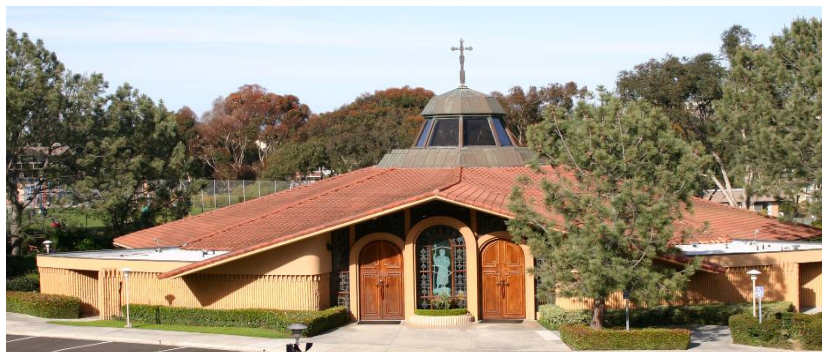

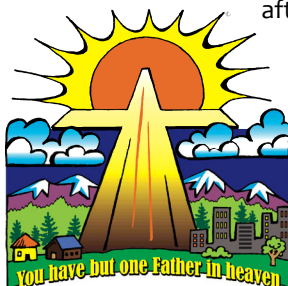

## GOD IS IN CHARGE

"Who do you think you are?!" today's readings demand. We are brought up short, put in our place, given a dose of reality. Who is God? Who is in charge? Who is the greatest? We begin with a passage from the prophet Malachi, one of the latest prophets, who wrote after the Jews returned from Babylon. Calling the people to task in



God's name, he condemns, the divisions and false teachings that have arisen, reminding them that all were created by the one God. Paul tells the Thessalonians the same thing, but in a positive way—praising them for remembering that it is God who is at work within them. Finally, the Gospel presents Jesus speaking out against hypocrisy and vainglory. "You have but one teacher...you have but one Father" (Matthew 23:8, 9). We are firmly put in our place. God is in charge.

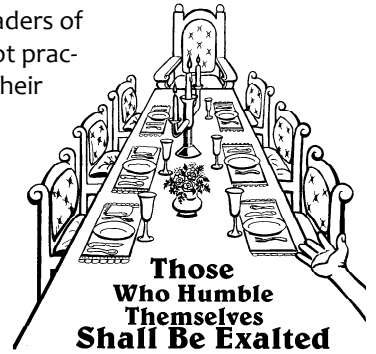
**STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION**

In today's Gospel, Christ says the religious leaders of the day, the Scribes and the Pharisees, do not practice what they preach. They seem to be using their positions of power for their own glory. Christ uses this example to teach a lesson — "Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and whoever humbles himself will be exalted."

In the second reading, St. Paul and his companions are in Thessalonica doing the Lord's work – proclaiming the Gospel, and, for the ability to do so, Paul says, "We give thanks to God unceasingly." They are there to serve the Lord, to show the people the truth of the Gospel and to rejoice with them as they convert to Christ. Talk about stewardship in action!

There's nothing wrong with being appreciated for our talents. But as Christian disciples and stewards of God's many gifts, we must always remember that all good things come from Him, and we must live our lives in humble service and in gratitude for all He has given us.

**FOLLOWING THE EXAMPLE OF ST. DAMIEN**

How much time do you dedicate to prayer each day? When pondering the three T's of stewardship—time, talent and treasure—the "time" component holds the position of greatest importance; it serves as the fertile ground from which the gifts of talent and treasure blossom. Only by spending time in prayer each day and receiving the sacraments are we able to consistently and generously donate our talent and treasure to the Church. A wonderful example of Stewardship of Time is the story of St. Damien. Shortly after being ordained a priest, he volunteered to serve a colony of lepers isolated on the island of Molokai, Hawaii. From May 1873 to his death in 1889 (age 49), he worked to restore within the lepers a sense of personal worth and dignity. Although for some time, St. Damien took the necessary precautions to ensure that he did not contract leprosy, he knew that physical touch was necessary to communicate his love and concern. With great humility and sacrifice, St. Damien offered his own life in order to save the lives of others. From where did he draw strength? St. Damien found his strength in the Mass. Prayer was the impetus behind the generosity of this faithful servant of God, and is the fuel that ignites every heart to flame in love. Without prayer and grace that flows from the sacraments, we are incapable of leading lives of service and responding to God's call!

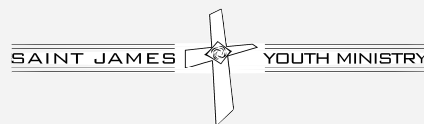

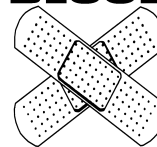

## REFLEXION DOMINICAL

En el Evangelio de hoy, Cristo dice a los líderes religiosos los Escribas y los Fariseos, no practican lo que predicán. Parecen estar utilizando sus posiciones del poder para su propia gloria.
