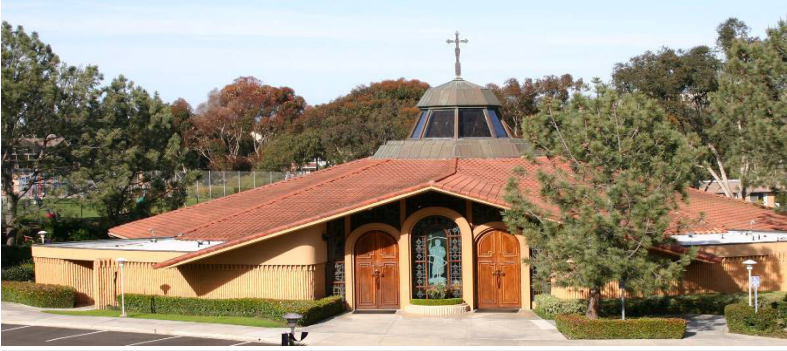

Beginning Tuesday, November 9, St James Hall

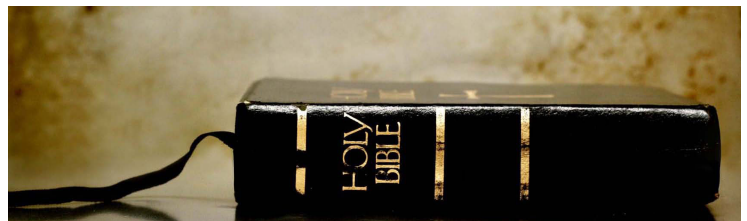

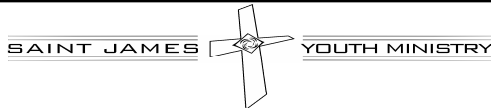

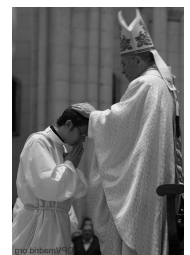
