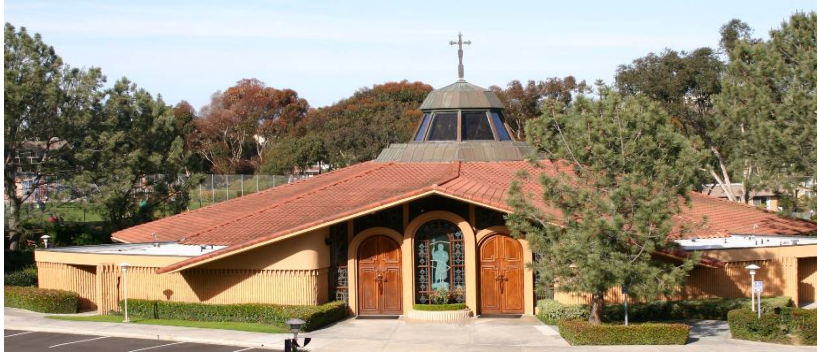

### *Advent Reflection:*

Today there is an abrupt shift in the season of Advent. From here on the tone is more joyful and expectant and the tug of the Christmas message is irresistible. At daily Mass tomorrow we begin to unfold the story of Jesus' birth. Who can resist the beauty of the first reading today—deserts aflame with flowers, arthritics set to dancing, the tone-deaf singing hymns? So we don't miss the change, the parish may take rose-colored vestments out of moth-balls, we may light rose-colored candles on the wreath, or fill in our wreaths with desert flowers, pink seashells, seed pods, cones and berries. The seeds of God's kingdom have been sown in us. In these shining days of Advent they are sprouting in many ways. How do we bring the promise to light? This is the week to prepare gifts for the poor. It is the week to invite a lonely neighbor to your Christmas dinner, the week to write a note forgiving a lost friend, the week to shatter a family grudge so that even in the desert places of your heart, Christ's life may blossom.

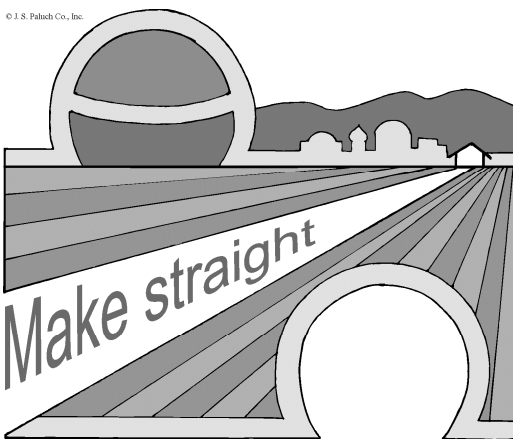

**STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION**

Today, we celebrate Gaudete Sunday. In the midst of our preparations for Christmas, we are reminded to stop and spend time rejoicing for what God has done for us.



**the way of the Lord**

It is interesting, however, to note that the writers of today’s readings are not simply rejoicing in the mystery of the incarnation. In the reading from Isaiah, the prophet rejoices because the Lord has sent Him to proclaim glad tidings to the poor, to heal the broken hearted, to proclaim liberty to captives, and release to prisoners.” Today’s Responsorial Psalm, the Magnificat, echoes these same sentiments. In the Gospel reading, we find John the Baptist rejoicing in the mission God has given Him. He tells those who have gathered around Him that He is not the Messiah. He tells them, “I am the voice of the one crying out in the desert, ‘Prepare the way of the Lord.’”

What’s more, in his letter to the Thessalonians, St. Paul reminds us as the Christian Church to rejoice always. We are called to rejoice, proclaim and, as stewards, to use the many things God has given us – our time, our talents, and our treasure – to help others recognize the many good things God does for us.

**A SIMPLER CHRISTMAS**

- Forget the “ideal” Christmas: put the emphasis on Jesus.
- Drop any Christmas activity you hate.
- Dread sending Christmas cards? Go to catholicgreetings.org or a similar site and send e-cards with a few mouse clicks.
- Hosting Christmas dinner? Have family pitch in and ask guests to bring something.
- Don’t spend what you don’t have. Set a dollar limit and stick to it.
- Consider a family gift exchange, a donation to charity, gifts under a giving tree. Give coupons for time and talent gifts. Buy faith-related gifts at your parish bookstore.
- Create your own traditions: a Christmas nativity scene, Christmas candles, Midnight Mass, read the Christmas stories, serve dinner in a shelter.
- Don’t expect anyone to behave in certain ways or to give you the right gifts.
- Don’t do anything to excess: gift-giving, partying, drinking, eating.
- Don’t fight with family, especially over who goes to church.

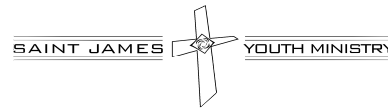

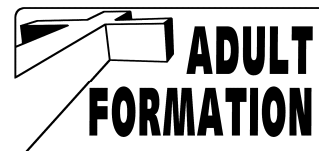
## Adult Faith Formation Presents: BOOK OF EXODUS BIBLE STUDY Begins Tuesday, January 10th at 7:00 PM

## REFLECTION DOMINICAL

Hoy celebramos el Domingo Gaudete. En medio de los preparativos para la Navidad, nos recuerda que debemos dejar pasar el tiempo y regocijo por lo que Dios ha hecho por nosotros.
