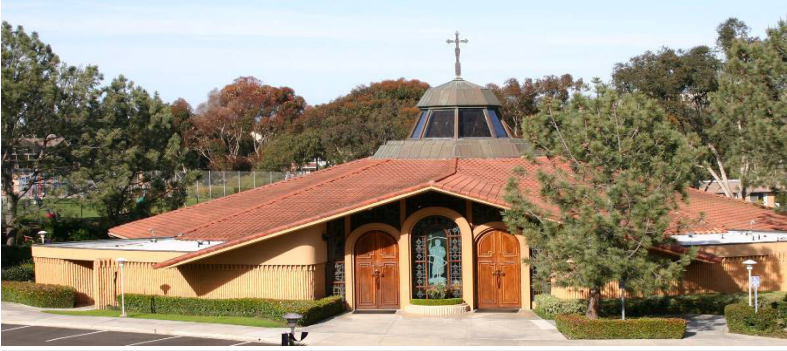

## Fifth Sunday of Lent - April 10, 2011

**Second Reading** — If Christ is in you, the spirit is alive even if the body is dead because of sin (Romans 8:8-11).

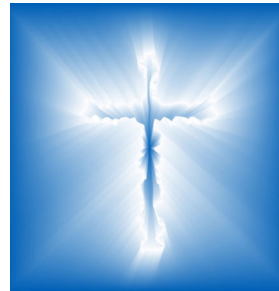

### Give Glory to God

On the Fifth Sunday of Lent, just before we begin to enter Holy Week, we are summoned to Bethany. If we had been friends of Mary, Lazarus, and Martha, and found out that Lazarus was gravely ill, we probably would have dropped everything to be with them. This was what was so surprising about the behavior of Jesus. Although he was their close friend, he chose to stay away, that God's glory would be manifested. This is a persistent theme in John's Gospel. Right to the very end, Jesus' works were meant to give glory to the Father. As our Lenten journey reaches a crescendo, let us be mindful that, as people who have "put on Christ" in baptism, we are also called, by our attitudes and actions, to give glory to God.

**New Responsibilities**

This past October the Provincial Assembly of the North American Province of the Eudist Fathers voted to establish a semi-autonomous administrative region for the members of our Congregation working in the United States. This new administrative structure makes it easier for members of our apostolic society to make decisions locally concerning our future. This past week, I have been appointed the first Regional Superior of the newly created Eudist American Region. This does not affect my position as pastor of St. James and St. Leo but it means that I will assume additional responsibilities concerning the Eudist priests, associates and seminarians in the United States. At this time, the Eudists work in four parishes in the San Diego Diocese and have the pastoral care of two parishes, St. James and St. Patrick's in Carlsbad. We also have a parish in Phoenix and plan to accept a parish in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles. We have a House of Formation for our candidates in La Mesa, CA, and nine candidates at different levels of formation to the priesthood. This coming May 5, we will have our second priestly ordination in two and half years when transitional deacon Juan Gabriel Garcia will be ordained priest at St. Patrick's by Cardinal Oscar Rodriguez of Honduras. Thank you for your prayers and constant support.

**Stewardship Reflection**

Lazarus and his two sisters Mary and Martha were good friends with Jesus. The sisters sent word to Jesus when Lazarus became ill, but before Jesus got there, Lazarus died. Jesus told Martha, "I am the resurrection and the life, whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die," and asked her, "Do you believe this?" She responded, "Yes, Lord. I have come to believe that you are the Christ, the Son of God, the one who is coming into the world." Although sharing normal human grief at the death of his friend, Jesus called to Lazarus in the tomb, "Come out!" With his life restored, Lazarus did so.

Even though Lazarus had his natural life restored, rather than receiving the glorified life that Jesus has had since his resurrection, the raising of Lazarus demonstrated Jesus' power over death. And, as St. Paul wrote to the Romans, the Holy Spirit dwells in Christians and gives us new spiritual life even now; and Christ will raise our bodies in his glorified form at the end of time. This hope causes us to view the Time, Talent, and Treasure entrusted to us from the viewpoint of how we can use them for God's glory and the benefit of others, for we know our response has an eternal reward.

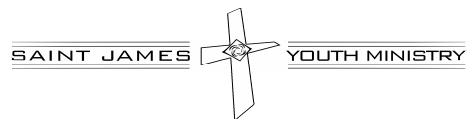

**Reflexión**

Lázaro y sus dos hermanas María y Martha eran buenos amigos con Jesús. Las hermanas enviaron un mensaje a Jesús que Lázaro estaba enfermo. Antes de que viniera Jesús Lázaro murió. Jesús le dijo a Martha, "Yo soy la resurrección y la vida, quien cree en mi, si muere, vivirá, y todo aquel que vive y cree en mi nunca morirá", y le pregunta a ella, "Crees tú esto? Ella respondió, "Si Señor yo que creo que tú eres el Cristo, el hijo de Dios, que habría de venir al mundo". Aunque compartiendo una pena humana normal en la muerte de su amigo, Jesús llamó a Lázaro de la tumba, "Sal fuera" con su vida restaurada, Lázaro lo hizo así.
