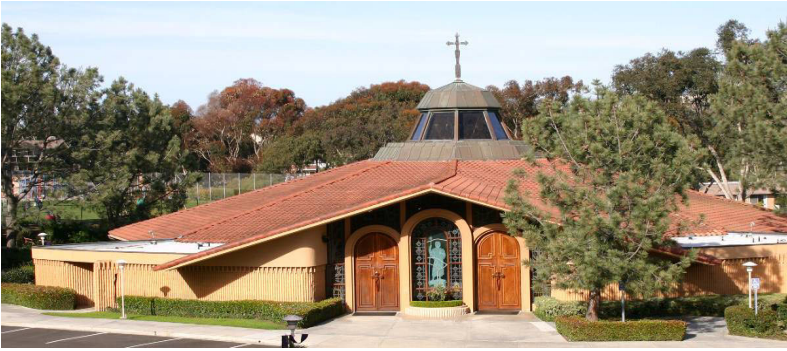

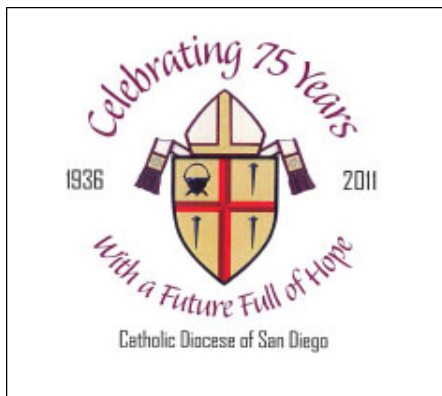

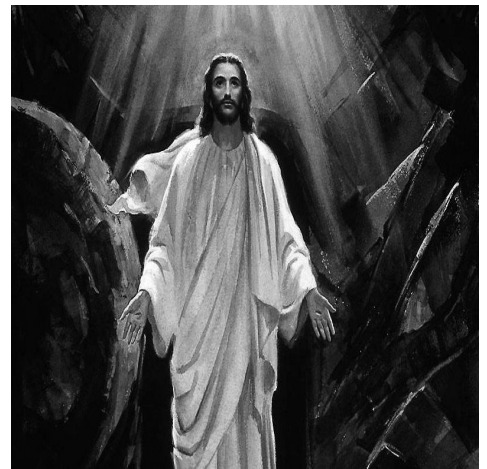

**Seeds of Faith**

There is a brevity, a certain terseness, in the scripture readings for Easter Sunday. Peter's speech in Acts is built of direct, pointed sentences. Paul's letters are based on straightforward creed-like statements. Even the Gospel story only briefly recounts what will turn out to be one of the most remarkable events in human history—the resurrection of Jesus from the dead. Advertising agents call these encapsulated points of information “bullet points.” Scripture scholars call them *kerygma*, or “kernels” of our faith. Actually, “kernels” or “seeds” are good terms for these statements, since throughout the Easter season, we will hear in the Acts of the Apostles, the Letters of Paul and the Gospel accounts of the days following the Resurrection, exactly how these *kerygma* began to flower, how they continued to grow through the life of the early church. May these Easter “seeds” of faith serve a similar purpose for us, too, so that the life of the Risen Christ will flourish in us and through our witness in the coming days.

**Stewardship Reflection**

What difference does the Resurrection of Jesus make to us? What reaction should we have? The response to the Psalm sums it up: "This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad." Joy and gratitude are the most appropriate responses, but they need to be given a concrete form to make a lasting difference in our lives.

In the sermon by St. Peter that we heard in the Reading from Acts, we're told two great truths:

He commissioned us to preach to the people and testify that he is the one appointed by God as judge of the living and the dead. To him all the prophets bear witness, that everyone who believes in him will receive forgiveness of sins through his name.

All who believe that Jesus is the Christ will receive forgiveness of sins. He is appointed to be the judge of all, living or dead. Those are two amazing statements.

In the Second Reading to the Colossians, St. Paul gives us advice to guide the way we live as we try to apply the truth of the Resurrection in our lives. Through Baptism, we have been united with Christ in his death and resurrection, and so, Paul writes, "If then you were raised with Christ, seek what is above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Think of what is above, not what is on earth." Think of what is above, think of heavenly life. Do not limit your thoughts to earthly concerns that will pass away.

It's in light of this perspective that we are to live as stewards. Think of what is above when you make your decisions of how you use the time, the talent, and the treasure God has entrusted to you. What will you have to report to the judge of the living and the dead?

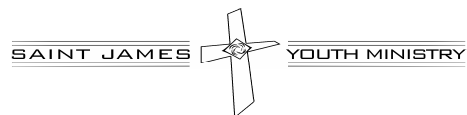

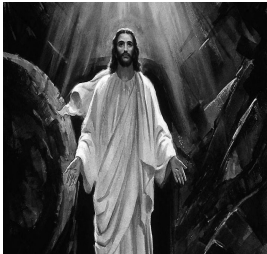

### Reflexión sobre la Administración

¿Qué diferencia hace la Resurrección de Jesús en nosotros? ¿Qué reacción debemos tener nosotros? La respuesta se resume en el Salmo: *"Este es el día que el señor ha hecho; alegrémonos y estemos contentos"*. Gozo y gratitud son las mas grandes respuestas apropiadas, que se deben dar en una forma concreta para hacer una diferencia duradera en nuestras vidas.

En el sermón dicho por san Pedro hemos escuchados en la lectura de los Hechos de los Apóstoles dos gran verdades: *"El fue enviado a nosotros a predicar y testificar que es el designado por Dios como juez de la vida y de la muerte. De él todos los profetas, dieron testimonio para que todos los que crean en él recibirá el perdón de los pecados por su nombre."*

Estas son dos declaraciones asombrosas. En la Lectura de la Segunda carta a los colosense, San Pablo nos aconseja y nos guía a vivir para aplicar la verdad de la resurrección en nuestras vidas. Por el Bautismo, nosotros hemos sido unidos con Cristo en su muerte y resurrección, y así, Pablo escribe, "si entonces fuimos resucitados con Cristo, busquen las cosas de arriba, donde Cristo está sentado a la derecha de Dios. Piensen en lo que es arriba, no lo que está en la tierra" Piense en lo que es arriba, en la vida celestial. No limite sus pensamientos a preocupaciones terrenales que se morirán

Es a la luz de esta perspectiva que debemos vivir como administradores. Piense en lo que es de arriba cuando tome una decisión de cómo utilizar **el Tiempo, el Talento, y el Tesoro** que Dios ha confiado a usted. ¿Qué tendrá usted que responder al juez de la vida y de la muerte?
