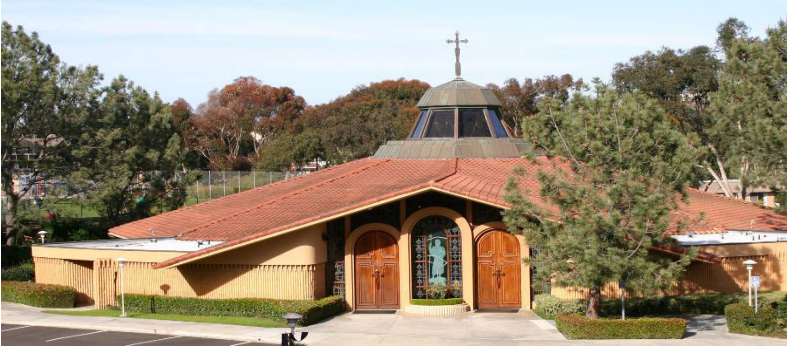

Stewardship Reflection

“I am the light of the world,” Jesus said, “Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of the life” (Jn 8:12). Writing to the Ephesians, St. Paul urged the Christians, those who recognize that Jesus is the light of the world, to “live as children of light, for light produces every kind of goodness and righteousness and truth” (Eph 5:8-9). He knew that Christ Himself is the light, but the light of Christ radiates out through those who have turned to Him. The person who responds to Jesus’ invitation is like David, whom Samuel anointed in God’s name. Just as “the spirit of the Lord rushed upon David” (1 Sam 16:13), the Holy Spirit dwells in the Christian to shine forth with goodness and truth.

We may not all be learned theologians, or be able to explain all the fine points of Catholic doctrine. However, we should be able to do as the man born blind did, and that is to witness to what Christ has done in our lives. When he was being questioned in a second interrogation, when the Pharisees were trying to get him to condemn Jesus as a sinner, the man proclaimed, “One thing I do know is that I was blind and now I see” (John 9:25). It is hard to argue with people’s personal experience with God.

The man born blind experienced physical healing. We who have been given healing from spiritual blindness by Christ should also worship Jesus and use the time, the talents, and the treasure entrusted to us in ways that give evidence that we, too, believe that he is Lord.

This campaign will continue to push Congress and the administration toward US foreign assistance that is more effective in reducing poverty. Research from the Congressional Management Foundation confirms that handwritten, mailed letters are still the best way to communicate with your members of Congress. In fact, 96 percent of Capitol Hill staff reported in a survey that if their member of Congress had not reached a decision on an issue, personalized letters would influence his or her position.

Personalized emails can also be effective, but congressional offices experience large amounts of email and sometimes lack the additional staff to handle the volume and evaluate the authenticity of the emails. Handwritten letters from constituents of members of Congress are always read and logged.


Come Join Us for the Palm Sunday Procession!
