Stewardship Reflection

The two disciples who traveled from Jerusalem to Emmaus on the afternoon of the first Easter Sunday had an exceptional experience. They had the opportunity to hear the risen Jesus interpret all the Old Testament references to himself. Yet they did not recognize him until at the meal he took bread and broke it. They realized that it was he who been teaching them and had just celebrated the Eucharist.

We get to meet Jesus in the same way when we attend Mass. During the first part of Mass, the Liturgy of the Word, the Scriptures are read and expounded in the homily, so we hear God's message to us. Then in the Liturgy of the Eucharist, the bread and wine are consecrated to become the Body and Blood of Christ, and Christ himself becomes present to us.

To encounter Jesus in this way requires only one thing from us - to be present. And so we're asked to make a commitment of Time, time to be with one who loves us enough to have died for us and one who loves us enough to raise us to live with him eternally. To get to know the Lord Jesus better, we have to commit Time to worship at Mass, to study the Bible, and to pray. But what a marvelous reward is the result!

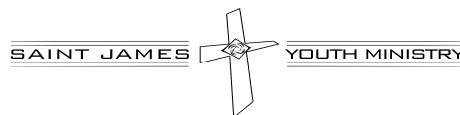

San Diego Blood Bank

Will be at St. James on Sunday, May 22, from 7:30AM to 1:00PM. to receive blood donations. The need for blood remains great throughout the county and state, and we urge your participation. Bringing it close to home, we have had several parishioners whose lives have been saved by blood transfusions, and over the years we've been doing it, your donations have saved over 9,000 lives. Remember: people are the only source --there is no substitute. Let's give them a big turnout! Appointments are not required, but are advisable, especially right after Mass lets out.

For your convenience, you may make an appointment either by: visiting the Blood Bank website at MY-SDBB.org or calling the Blood Bank 1-800-4MY-SDBB 1 800 469-7322 or calling Bob or Cory Graves at 858 755-8990 or emailing Bob at robtgraves@wwdb.org.

The first time you donate blood each year, you automatically create a Blood Assurance Program for your own family. Thereafter, you may donate a credit to anyone you choose. It may be given to the Parish, or to any other group, or to a person of your choosing who has an immediate need for blood.

Blood donations credited to the Parish are available to any parishioner, or to a member of the immediate family of a parishioner, at any time; whenever blood is needed, contact the rectory office. The Blood Bank will make available as many units of blood as are needed, at absolutely no charge to the patient.

Reflexión

Los dos discípulos que viajaron de Jerusalén a Emmaus en la tarde del primer el Domingo de Resurrección tuvieron una experiencia excepcional. Ellos tuvieron la oportunidad de escuchar a Jesús resucitado interpretando todas las referencias del antiguo Testamento sobre él mismo. Mas no lo reconocieron hasta que en la cena tomara pan y lo partiera. Se dieron cuenta de que él fue quien los había estado enseñando y celebrado la Eucaristía.

Conseguimos reunimos con Jesús de la misma manera cuando asistimos a la misa. Durante la primera parte de la misa, la Liturgia de la Palabra, las Escrituras son leídas y expuestas en la homilía, así que oímos el mensaje de Dios a nosotros. Entonces en la Liturgia de la Eucaristía, el pan y el vino son consagrados y llega a ser el cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo que él mismo se hace presente a nosotros.

Para encontrarse con Jesús de esta manera se requiere sólo una cosa de nosotros estar presente. Y así que estamos pidiendo hacer un compromiso de **Tiempo**, el tiempo de estar con uno que nos ama lo suficiente para haber muerto por nosotros y nos ama lo suficiente para resucitarnos y vivir con él eternamente. Para conocer mejor al Señor Jesús tenemos que comprometer **el tiempo** de adoración en la Misa, de estudiar la Biblia, y de orar. Y lo que resulta será una recompensa maravillosa.
