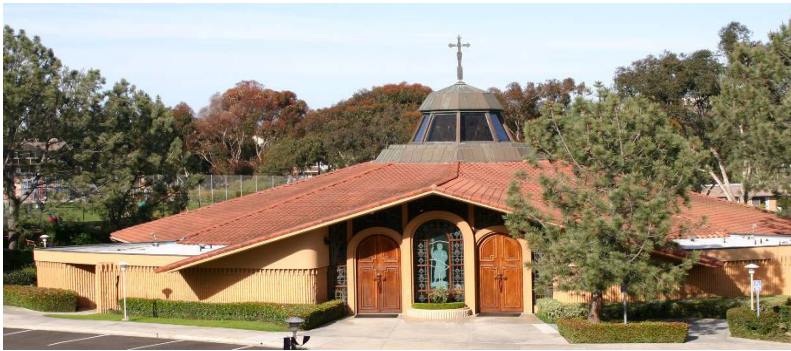

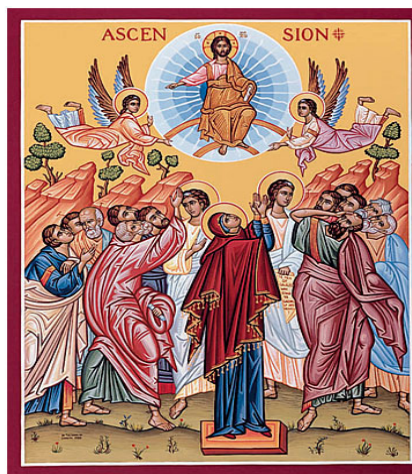

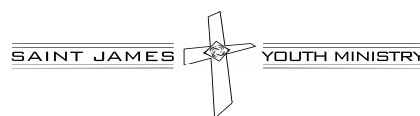

Reflexión

Poco antes de su Ascensión, Jesús encargó a los apóstoles con la tarea de esparcir el Evangelio al mundo entero. En aquel momento ellos no supieron exactamente lo que significaba y cómo ellos lo harían. Mas en su Ascensión Jesús reasumió su gloria celestial y empezó su ministerio de intercesión para nosotros. El entonces envió al Espíritu Santo para autorizar, indicar, y para santificar la Iglesia
