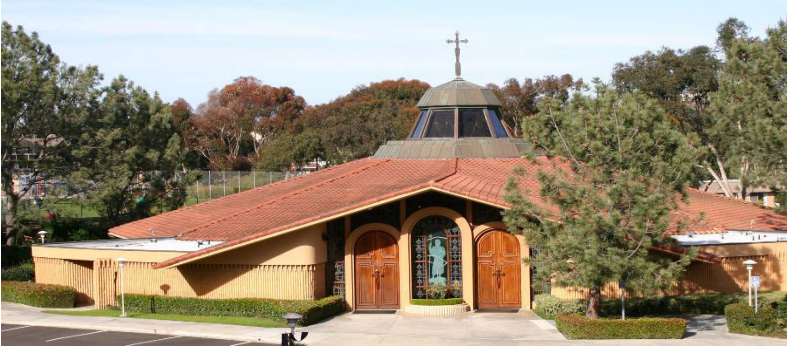

## Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time - July 10, 2011



St. James—St. Leo Catholic Community is under the pastoral care of the Eudist Fathers, or Congregation of Jesus and Mary. We owe our name to Saint John Eudes who founded the Congregation in France in 1643. The Eudists currently operate in 15 countries, most of which are in the developing world. Evangelization, mainly with the poor and the youth, is our primary purpose, as well as formation to ministry in the training of diocesan priests and lay ministers. For decades the bronze bell rang out from St. Leo Mission tower. It joyfully proclaimed hundreds of births, baptisms, marriages and the celebration of sacred Mass. It rang slowly and solemnly acknowledging the deaths and passing of parishioners-- those especially loved and remembered. Likewise, it announced many other celebrations and remembrances. Most importantly it served to remind residents and parishioners of Christ's presence!

In 2004 the wooden bell tower was discovered to be termite ridden and had to be demolished. One might ask, "Where is the Bell today?"—"the bell which was such a significant and integral part of the spiritual life of the community?"

It lies in the back of St. Leo Church, covered with a canvas tarp, protecting it from the elements. A group of parishioners from both churches are championing the restoration of the bell and the tower. In this Centennial year it seems a fitting tribute to those who struggled to establish the parish and so actively participated in the life of the Church.

The bell will be transported to St. James Church's, Patio of the Bells, for Bishop Brom's celebration of a Centennial Mass, thanking God for all the blessings He has bestowed upon St.

James-St. Leo Catholic Community over the last 100 years. The bell will be blessed as an official sign of our commitment to its restoration as an important part of our legacy.

**STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION ...**

In the Parable of the Sower, the seed is the word of God, and Christ is the sower. We, the hearers, are the soils on which the seed falls. All of us must examine ourselves. Is my soul hardened by sin, so I don't hear Christ and I resemble the path with its hard soil beaten by constant travelers? Am I like the rocky ground, eager to respond but shallow so I cannot take rejection or persecution for the sake of Christ? Do I let the cares and concerns and temptations of the world choke my spiritual life? Or am I good soil in which a fruitful harvest is growing?

Clearing our life of stones and weeds is a lifetime task, but we need to work at it and seek God's grace to assist. Speaking through Isaiah, God stated that his word shall do his will. As stewards we are called to use our time, talent, and treasure so God's word will "yield a fruitful harvest" in our lives, as the Responsorial Psalm puts it. As the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* (1724) puts it, "By the working of the Word of Christ, we slowly bear fruit in the Church to the glory of God."



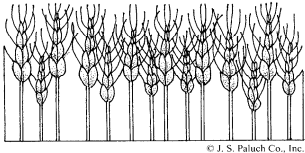

#### Reflexión semanal

En la parábola del sembrador, la semilla es la palabra de Dios, y Cristo es el sembrador. Nosotros, los oyentes, somos la tierra en que la semilla cae. Todos nosotros debemos examinarnos. ¿Es mi alma insensible al pecado, así no oigo a Cristo y me parezco al sendero con su tierra dura batida por los constantes viajeros? ¿Soy como el suelo rocoso, ansioso de responder pero tan superficial que no puedo aceptar el rechazo por Cristo? He permitido que los cuidados y las preocupaciones y las tentaciones del mundo estrangulen mi vida espiritual? o soy tierra buena en la que una cosecha fructífera pueda crecer?
