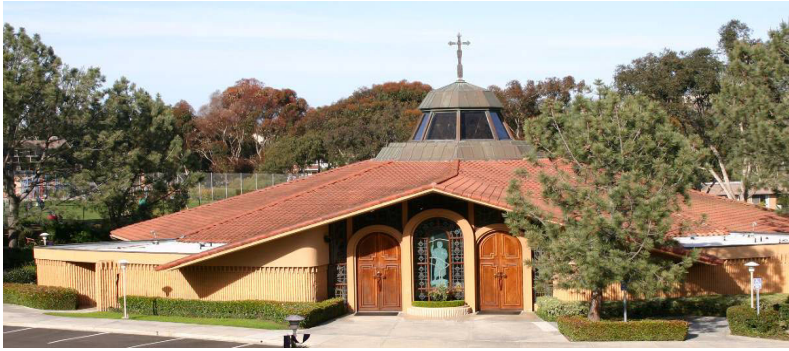

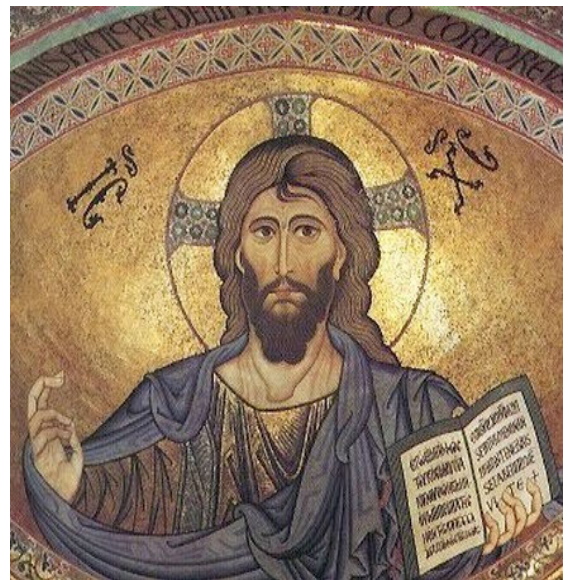

Stewardship Reflections...

The prayer of Jesus praising the Father for hiding his truth from the learned and wise was not intended to provide an excuse for students not to study. Instead he was contrasting what the world values as wisdom and learning with the true wisdom revealed by God, whose standards are the opposite of those of the world.

The same theme appears in the prophecy of Zechariah who proclaimed that he Messiah would be humble and peaceful when most expected him to be a military conqueror. And again, St. Paul wrote to the Roman Christians to follow the leading of the Holy Spirit instead of living "according to the flesh," our sinful human desires which govern most people.

The way to begin is by thanking God and praising him, as we sing in Psalm 145, "I will praise your name forever, my king and my God." Thanksgiving takes our attention off ourselves and directs it toward God, who is the source of our time, talent, and treasure. Realizing that all we have comes from him as gifts, we become willing to share them, and so discover true wisdom.

Stewardship—A way of life or THE way of life?

In 1992 the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops drafted its pastoral letter, *Stewardship: A Disciples Response*.

Stewardship was and is a concept grounded in scripture and the sacraments, and through this concept, we learn that "God is Love," and out of this love, we have all received the great gift of life. During the course of this life we learn that all that we are, all that we have, and all that we will ever be, is a gift from God. In recognition of these gifts, we are reminded in scripture: **"As each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God's varied grace."** (1 Peter 4:10)

Likewise, when we receive the Sacrament of Baptism, we are all called to a life of discipleship. Subsequently, through the Sacrament of Confirmation, we are all called to go forth in service, witness and in action, sharing our varied giftedness in love of God and neighbor. Clearly we are all called to put our faith into action. We do this in the manner in which we share our giftedness in serving the needs of our families, while also expending that sharing — generously, sacrificially and proportionately — in serving, supporting and being actively involved in the mission of the parish, the diocese, and the universal Church.

Stewardship is **"THE"** way of life. It is not optional. Stewardship is also **"A"** way-of-life. But the U.S. Bishops make it clear in the preface of *Stewardship: A Disciples Response*, on page 1, when they state: **"Once one chooses to become a disciple of Jesus Christ, stewardship is not and option."**

On judgment day, it will not matter whether it is "A" way of life or "THE" way-of-life. All that will matter will be our response to God as to how we lived that way of life in love and service to God and neighbor between the dates

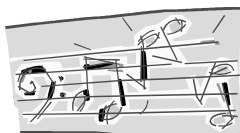
Very Big News from St. James Academy!

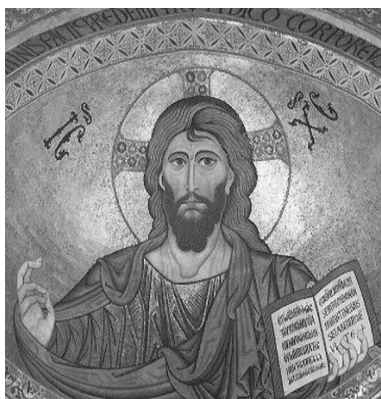

Reflexión semanal

La oración de Jesús que alaba al Padre para ocultar su verdad del conocimiento y la sabiduría no tuvo la intención de proporcionar una excusa a los estudiantes para no estudiar. En su lugar el contrastaba lo que el mundo valora como sabiduría y conocimiento con la verdadera sabiduría revelada por Dios, cuyos niveles son opuestos a los del mundo.

El mismo tema parece en la profecía de Zacarías que proclamo que el Mesías sería humilde y pacífico cuando la mayoría esperaba que fuera un conquistador militar. Y otra vez, san Pablo escribió a los cristianos de Roma que siguieran el ejemplo del Espíritu Santo en vez de vivir “según la carne,” ya que los deseos humanos pecadores son los que gobiernan a la mayoría de las personas.

La manera de empezar es dando gracias a Dios y alabándolo, como cantamos en el Salmo 1345, “alabare su nombre par a siempre, mi rey y mi Dios.” La acción de gracias quita nuestro atención y lo dirige hacia Dios, que es la fuente de nuestro tiempo, talento, y tesoro. Darse cuenta de que todos hemos venido de el como regalos, nosotros debemos estar dispuestos a compartirlos y así descubrir la verdadera sabiduría.
