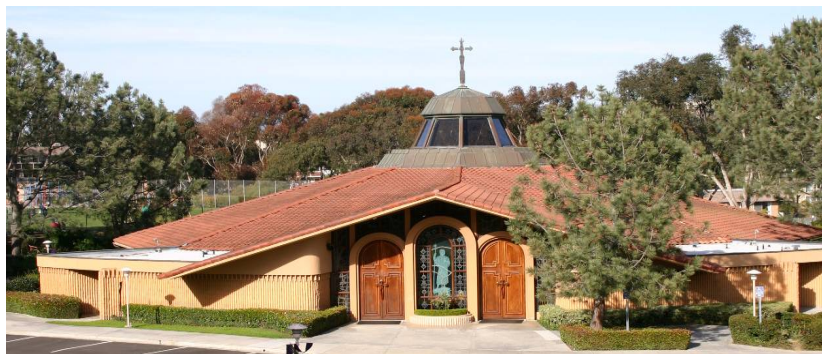

THE CROSS OF JESUS

The perception of a cross changed dramatically after Jesus' crucifixion. Before that event, death on a cross was not only horrible, it was degrading. It was a penalty reserved only for the most wretched of criminals. The word “glory” would not have found its way into the same sentence containing the word “cross.” But all that changed with Jesus. Over time, believers began to venerate and honor the cross. They painted, sculpted, and carved images of it. Many lost their own lives for their association with it. Today our reverence for and relationship with the cross recalls little of the contempt originally associated with it. As it has been through the ages, it is our perception of the cross that determines how we follow Jesus. —J.S. Paluch Co.

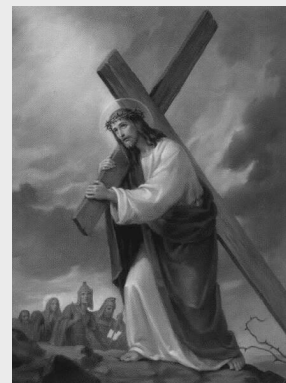

STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Jesus throws out a challenge to all who wish to follow him in today's Gospel. Immediately after St. Peter identified him as "the Christ, the Son of the living God," Jesus declares that he is not the sort of Christ people expected. Instead of being a conquering hero, he must suffer greatly and be killed. Even worse, each of his followers "must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."

That's the contradiction of the Christian life. The fallen world, what St. Paul terms "this age," is centered on self – indulging what our wills want so we can achieve maximum pleasure, power, and prestige. But Christians are called to let our minds be transformed and renewed by Jesus Christ, so that our wills are conformed to the will of God. We die to self so we can live for God. When we allow God's formation to renew our minds, we discover that it changes how we use our time, apply our talent, and spend our treasure. We pray, "Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done on earth, as it is in heaven." When our minds have been renewed by God's grace, we do our best to make this prayer come true.

FEAST OF FAITH

The oldest account of what happened at the Last Supper comes to us not from the Gospels but from the First Letter of Saint Paul to the Corinthians: "I received from the Lord what I also handed on to you, that the Lord Jesus, on the night he was handed over, took bread, and, after he had given thanks, broke it and said, 'This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me' " (11:23–24). In our celebrations of the Eucharist, we are obedient to Christ's command to "do this." The priest, acting in the person of Christ, does what Jesus did and says what Jesus said. He takes bread, gives thanks, breaks it, and gives it to the Lord's disciples. He takes wine, gives thanks, shares it with us. We believe that the entire Eucharistic Prayer is consecratory, but we continue to hold these words of Jesus in special reverence. They are called the words of consecration, and the elevations of the host and chalice, the genuflections of the priest, and the optional ringing of a bell and use of incense remind us that we are in the presence of the Lord.

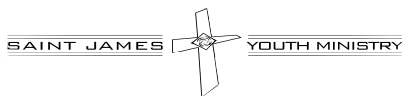

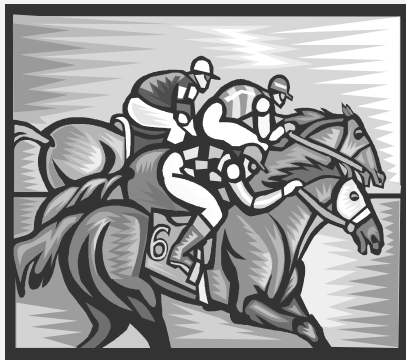

REFLEXION SEMENAL

Jesús lanza un desafío a todos los que desea seguirlo en el Evangelio de hoy. Inmediatamente después San Pedro lo identificó como "el Cristo, el Hijo del Dios vivo," Jesús declara que él no es el tipo de mesías que el pueblo esperó. En vez de ser un héroe que conquista, debe sufrir mucho y morir. Todavía peor, cada uno de sus seguidores "debe negarse, tomar su cruz, y seguirle." "Para quienquiera que desea guardar su vida la perderá, pero quienquiera que pierda su vida por mí la encontrará."

Esa es la contradicción de la vida cristiana. La caída del mundo, lo que San Pablo llama "este tiempo," está centrado en si mismo – satisfaciendo lo que nuestra voluntad desea alcanzando el máximo placer, el poder, y el prestigio.
